MUNICIPAL CAPITAL PROJECTS & INFRASTRUCTURE

The upgrade to the Water Plant is essentially complete. There are a few little items remaining, such as landscaping the exterior, and smaller things like door trim etc to complete the inside. We would like to thank everyone for their patience for the duration of this project. We feel that the end product was definitely worth the wait. This is a new system and we are drawing from two new wells so there are likely to be a few kinks and hiccups along the way but we will address those as they happen. We would like to ask the residents of the Town to be mindful of watering their lawns and gardens. The much needed rain has certainly helped but prior to the rain, excessive watering put a great deal of strain on the town reservoir. Also if you haven't disconnected your water softener and r/o system yet, they should no longer be needed.

2018 Budget and Tax Policy Information

The 2018 Operating and Capital Budget was considered and passed by the Council of the Town of Milestone on April 10, 2018.

The following Tax Policy information was passed and applied to the Total Taxable Assessment for the Town of Milestone is 54,237,940:

2018 Municipal Mill rate -4.597 mills Base Tax - \$215.00 - Ag Land, Res Land, Comm Land Base Tax - \$815.00 Land& Improvements - Ag, Res, Comm

Applying the above Tax Policy to the Taxable Assessment results in a Municipal Tax Levy of approximately \$513,246

Municipal Operating Revenues, excluding any capital grant allocations that may be received, total \$982,347; Operating expenses, excluding depreciation of asset calculations and capital purchases total \$980,993.

<u>BACK LANES:</u> Rain hasn't been an issue for some time but recently we've been fortunate to have some moisture again. The Town does not maintain back lanes, so please avoid back lanes after a rainfall as the lanes get rutted up and in some instances adjacent private property has been damaged. Council is requesting your cooperation.

MILESTONE LANDFILL - IMPORTANT CHANGES

Saskatchewan Environment has recently stepped up compliance enforcement for all **WASTE DISPOSAL SITES** (Landfills) in the Province. Many communities are starting to modify current landfill practices in response to these warnings. Milestone was identified in a compliance inspection last August and a number of activities were identified as non-compliant. Non-compliance by the town will result in significant fines and possible closure of the site. As a result of these issues, a more stringent supervision of the Landfill by Town of Milestone staff will be in effect. Continued violations could lead to closure of the landfill.

GARBAGE PICKUP

Garbage pickup in the residential areas is currently scheduled for Friday mornings. Residents may have noticed the times for pick up has fluctuated occasionally and some residents have missed pickup. There are a number of neighboring communities on the same pick up schedule as the Town of Milestone so demand and load size may affect the times of pick up for our community. When Loraas was first contracted for residential pick up, residents were informed to have the garbage bins placed at the curb by 7am or the night before if possible.

Town Truck(s)

The old garbage truck is currently parked by the fire hall and is to be used for grass clippings and compostable materials only. The 3 ton truck will be left there for trees only. The Town crew will lend out the 3 ton during weekdays and we would like to ensure the truck is accessible to all residents beside the fire hall on weekends

When the recycling bin is full please notify the Town Office. Arrangements will be made to have the bin replaced. This is usually 1 or a 2-day turn around. Please flatten all cardboard. (Do not place full boxes of flattened cardboard in the bins – place them in individually, this creates less bulk.). Please do not place recyclable material beside the bin – BE PATIENT: WAIT UNTIL THE BIN IS REPLACED

Yearly Compliance Report for Drinking Water
