

BYLAW 1-98

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF MILESTONE TO REGULATE THE OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF MILESTONE


The council of the Town of Milestone, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. It shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile on the following public highways within the limits of the Town of Milestone
 - i) ON THAT PORTION OF CARRINGTON STREET lying between Railway Avenue and Provincial Highway No. 39
 - ii) ON THAT PORTION OF RAILWAY AVENUE lying between Carrington Street and Main Street
2. It shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile on any lane in the Town of Milestone for the sole purpose of moving the snowmobile on the most direct route to or from the place of residence to or from a point out of the town limits.
3. It shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile for the purpose of crossing any public highway in the Town of Milestone subject to the following conditions:
 - i) the crossing is at the intersection of a lane and highway
 - ii) the operator stops the snowmobile before entering upon the travelled portion of the highway
4. Subject to Sections 1, 2, 3, it shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile in the Town of Milestone between the hours of 8:00am and 11:00 PM.
5. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final passing thereof.
